The 124gr. Tap CQ ammunition was tested in a Springfield X D Tactical and a Colt Sub-gun.

The ammo performed well in both weapons with no malfunctions. The brass cases were smooth and caused no feeding problems. The ammo is hot enough that it fed in the sub-gun with no problem. At night the muzzle flash from the pistol was significant but was no problem from the longer barrel of the sub gun. I had no chronograph available to check velocity.

Penetration tests were conducted using water soaked telephone books. From the pistol at 15 yds. the ammo penetrated an average of 9 inches and bullets mushroomed the majority of the time. From the sub-gun at 15yds. the bullets penetrated an average of 12 inches and deformed well. Accuracy was good from an off hand firing stance. Advertised velocity is 1110 fps. at the muzzle from a test barrel.

This is good ammo and certainly worth considering for use for personal defense or police work.
