During a practical range testing of the 45 ACP 230 GR TAP CQ ammunition, it was found that the ammunition was very practical for law enforcement use. The ammunition was tested at the following ranges; 3 yards, 5 yards, 7 yards, 10 yards, 15 yards and 25 yards. For the testing there were 5 rounds used at each distance, using slow shoots for accuracy. The final ten rounds were spent at the 10 yard range using quick double-tap shooting.

Through the testing I found the accuracy to be perfect, numerous center hole shots were made with the ammunition. The ammunition was clean firing and I never had any miss-feeds or malfunctions with the ammo.

The ammunition was shot through a Glock model 21.

The product tested was Hornady's 45ACP TAP CQ round. This ammunition combines Hornady's XTP hollow point bullet and a low flash powder. The bullet is a 230 gr. Jacketed hollow point with a very deep expansion chamber and uniform serrations around the bullet head to ensure complete expansion. The product package lists

the muzzle velocity as 850fps, 809 fps at 50 yards and 771 fps at 100 yards. The ammo comes packaged in 20 round boxes; the cartridges arrived clean and bright, with no obvious defects or variations.

I tested this round in my HK USP 45c alongside Winchester Silvertips, and UMC 230gr ball. There were no malfunctions from any of the tested ammo. All shooting was done at 21 feet from the standing position. The TAP CQ best group was 6 rounds in a 1¾", while the Winchester was 1¼". The UMC managed a 2"+ group. All shooting was done in bright lighting so I noticed no difference in muzzle flash. There was no difference in felt recoil between the Hornady and Winchester. The UMC had noticeably more felt recoil. I did not have the resources to conduct penetration or expansion tests, nor could I chronograph the velocities.

The ballistics of this round have been well documented, and it compares well with other premium duty ammo on the market, and I would feel comfortable carrying this as my duty ammo.

I recently had the opportunity to test fire Hornady's .45 caliber 230 GR Hollow Point/XTP round. The test weapon was a Glock 21. I found the rounds easy to load in my magazines. Furthermore I was able to reload for faster follow up shots. I fired a total of 100 of the pistol rounds from distances of 7– 50 yards, which proved to be extremely accurate. Throughout the test, the ammunition performed flawlessly with no malfunctions. I field stripped my pistol after the test. No excessive dirt was found. Residue was comparable to other quality ammunition. I highly recommend this product to any tactical unit looking for an accurate and effective pistol round.
