These rounds were tested in a Springfield XD 40 subcompact and Glock 22. They performed consistently and had no problems with feeding even under rapid fire. Would recommend these for home defense as well as standard carry ammo.

This ammo is everything an officer can expect from modern ammo. Hornady is a major manufacturer and the quality of this ammo is very good. I generally shoot 180 gr .40 caliber ammo but at contact to 15 yds. I could find no difference in point of impact between this round

and my normal carry round.

I do not have access to a chronograph but I can assure you that this ammo is plenty hot. Penetration tests were conducted using water soaked telephone books. Penetration of this round averaged 9 inches firing from 15yds. Most of the bullets mushroomed well. The ammo functioned well and left the weapon fairly clean. These tests were conducted with a Glock Model 22.
